1.	Cleaning outside windows	Bring Window cleaner, buckets, cloths, a 3-step ladder
2.	Planting of colouring flowers & tidy up the yard	Bring Garden gloves, garden equipment, soil, flowers, etc
3.	Themed Vegetable Garden	Bring Seedlings, soil, garden equipment, etc
4.	CHOC House Bell	Rust treatment and bring equipment to paint including gold paint
5.	Driveway Mural Art	Paint and all equipment required-will share colours
6.	Change Painting at the play Area to include more bright colours	Different colour Paints and bring equipment required for painting the play area
7.	Painting the exterior of the shed and repacking it inside	Paint and bring all equipment required to paint. Will share colours required and bring with containers.
8.	Installation of Food Storage Shelving	Bring shelving or will share dimensions and shelving can be assembled at the house
9.	Painting of the precast wall	Paint the precast wall. Will share colours required. Bring equipment required for painting including paint
10.	CHOC House paving (re-painting)	Bring with painting and all that is required to paint the paving. Colours will be shared.
11.	Installation of CCTV Camera	Putting a new camera system
12.	Fixing of both vehicle gates	Restoration of our steel vehicle gate
13.	Spring Clean CHOC house including bathrooms, kitchen, lights, etc	Buckets, cloths, soap, etc
14.	Wash CHOC Vehicles	Bring cloths, a bucket, soap, etc
15.	Painting Trellis gates (burglar gates)	Bring paint preferably black and rust remover
16.	Wooden Framing Finding Thabo carpets	Wooden Frame
17.	Painting of CHOC house driveway wooden frame	Bring furnished paint and all accessories to refurbish the wooden frame
18.	Maintenance of the CHOC house	Bring DIY tools. Further, requesting donations of DIY tools to enable us to continue with house maintenance post-Mandela Day.
